## Sacramento County Republican Party Hopeful That Congress Will Now Get Back to Work

(Sacramento) It's been a good week for Republicans. Sacramento voters gathered in Folsom at the Veterans Hall on Wednesday night to watch the President give his State of the Union address. It was a sell-out crowd as families, college and high school students, seniors and millennials celebrated the many accomplishments of the Trump Administration as well as the Americans he highlighted for their service.

And Thursday, the Sacramento County Republican Party celebrated the acquittal of the President by the United States Senate. Democrats have obsessed over impeaching President Trump since the day he won election. "It's time to move forward. Democrats aren't good losers, and until President Trump took office, Republicans weren't the best winners," said Sacramento County Republican Party Chair Betsy Mahan. "We have a President now who is making good on his promises. No surprises. And it's time for Speaker Pelosi to put aside her attempts to make herself relevant to the new left, and work with the Administration on behalf of the American people."

"Voters will remember the image of Speaker Pelosi tearing up the State of the Union speech given to her by the President. They are very encouraged this will bode well for their endorsed Congressional candidates, including Tamika Hamilton running in CD 3, Christine Bish running in CD 6, and Buzz Patterson challenging Ami Bera in CD 7.
