Proposed Resolution 1-21 Calling for Unity in the Election to Recall Gavin Newsom

Whereas, the Sacramento County Republican Party has joined with other Californians to call for the removal of Governor Gavin Newsom through the Recall process; and

Whereas, the Recall of Newsom has qualified, and an election will take place on September 14, 2021; and

Whereas, there are 46 candidates, including 24 Republicans, who have been certified to be on the ballot for voters to consider as Newsom's replacement; and

Whereas, Governor Newsom cannot be replaced if a majority of voters do not vote "Yes" on Question 1 to remove him from office; and

Whereas, the Delegates of the California Republican Party, by a vote of 89.71%, in the interest of unity, decided not to endorse a candidate to replace Newsom; and

Whereas, within the 24 Republicans there are serious contenders, any of whom could serve as an effective Governor; and

Whereas, the Members of the Sacramento County Republican Party have not united behind a single candidate, and as individuals are passionately promoting their candidate of choice; and

Whereas, the enthusiasm of voters for their chosen candidate helps bring voters to the polls to accomplish the primary goal of recalling Gavin Newsom; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, the Sacramento County Republican Party acknowledges the wealth of talent in our Republican candidate pool and chooses not to endorse in the Recall Gavin Newsom Election; and be it further

Resolved, the Sacramento County Republican Party calls on all California voters to unify and elect the candidate of their choice who will honor the rights of taxpayers, parents, people of faith, workers, and businesses who need relief from Gavin Newsom's tyrannical and ineffective rule.
