## Statement by SacCountyGOP Chair on the CAGOP Recall Endorsement Vote

Sacramento, Calif.— (August 7, 2021) "I congratulate CAGOP Chairwoman Patterson for bringing the Recall endorsement vote to the full delegation, and support the decision not to endorse one candidate, said Sacramento County Republican Party Chair Betsy Mahan."

"The election that will take place starting August 16 is an opportunity for Republicans to inform all voters that there can be a better California. We don't have to breath smoke-filled air from fires that could have been prevented, our kids should come first over the interests of unions, our water should not need rationing, especially to farmers who feed the world, our businesses should not have to stand by while looters brazenly take their lives and livelihoods, our law enforcement should be thanked not villainized, we should be able to register our cars and fill the gas tank without having to remortgage our homes, and people of faith should not have to fear their right to gather and worship may be taken away."

"Most voters are not politically involved and don't care about a leader's Party, but they do care about quality of life. They're turning off the news and leaving social media because they no longer trust the messengers, and they are worried about the future for their children. While the Democrat Party holds all leadership positions in our major cities and in Sacramento, more voters are registered Republican and No Party Preference than Democratic. In fact, according to the CA Secretary of State's February registration report, 11,926,160 voters do not want to be Democrats. All voters deserve representation, and the Recall brings this opportunity."

"We need to ask California's workers and business owners, landlords and renters, parents and teachers, to answer the question: How's this working for you? And we need to let them know there's a wealth of talent in the Republicans who are running to replace the tyrant we know as Governor Newsom."
