SacCountyGOP Calls On Assemblyman Ken Cooley to Stop Promoting Proud Boy

Sacramento, California – The Sacramento County Republican Party today called on Assemblyman Ken Cooley to stop promoting the Proud Boy running against him for a new seat in the State Assembly.
