

ELECTION DETAILS

November 5, General Election

- Ballots will be mailed to all registered voters the first week in October. The final day to vote is Tuesday, November 5th. All voters are encouraged to VOTE EARLY so we don't need to use resources encouraging them to turn out.
- All Presidential candidates that qualified for their party in California will be on every ballot regardless of voter's party.
- There will be local and statewide initiatives and Bonds on the ballot.
- Seats up in November include local districts (fire, water, community service, recreation & parks, irrigation), Utility Districts, Community College & School Districts, City Council, Assembly, Senate, Congress, U.S. Senate and President.
- Candidates for local offices can start filing at their county elections office on July 15th. CAGOP will make trainings and resources available for all endorsed Republican candidates.
- There will be Vote Centers throughout each county available to vote in person (some open 11 days in advance, most 4 days in advance of Election Day), as well as drop boxes that are available as soon as ballots are mailed.
- Each County GOP will have their own version of ballot harvesting, such as accepting ballots in their headquarters that will be delivered to County Elections offices.
- All County GOP's will need volunteers to observe the November Election at Vote Centers and Drop Box locations throughout the County, and to contact voters to get out the vote. Visit this page to find your County GOP: https://cagop.org/counties
